- 1 From the main entrance, head around the right side of the **Great Meadow** until you see the pond.

Count how many different colors you can find in the flowers along the way!



- 2 Cross the bridge over the pond and continue straight under the trees.

Look for animals that live in and around the pond – what are they doing?



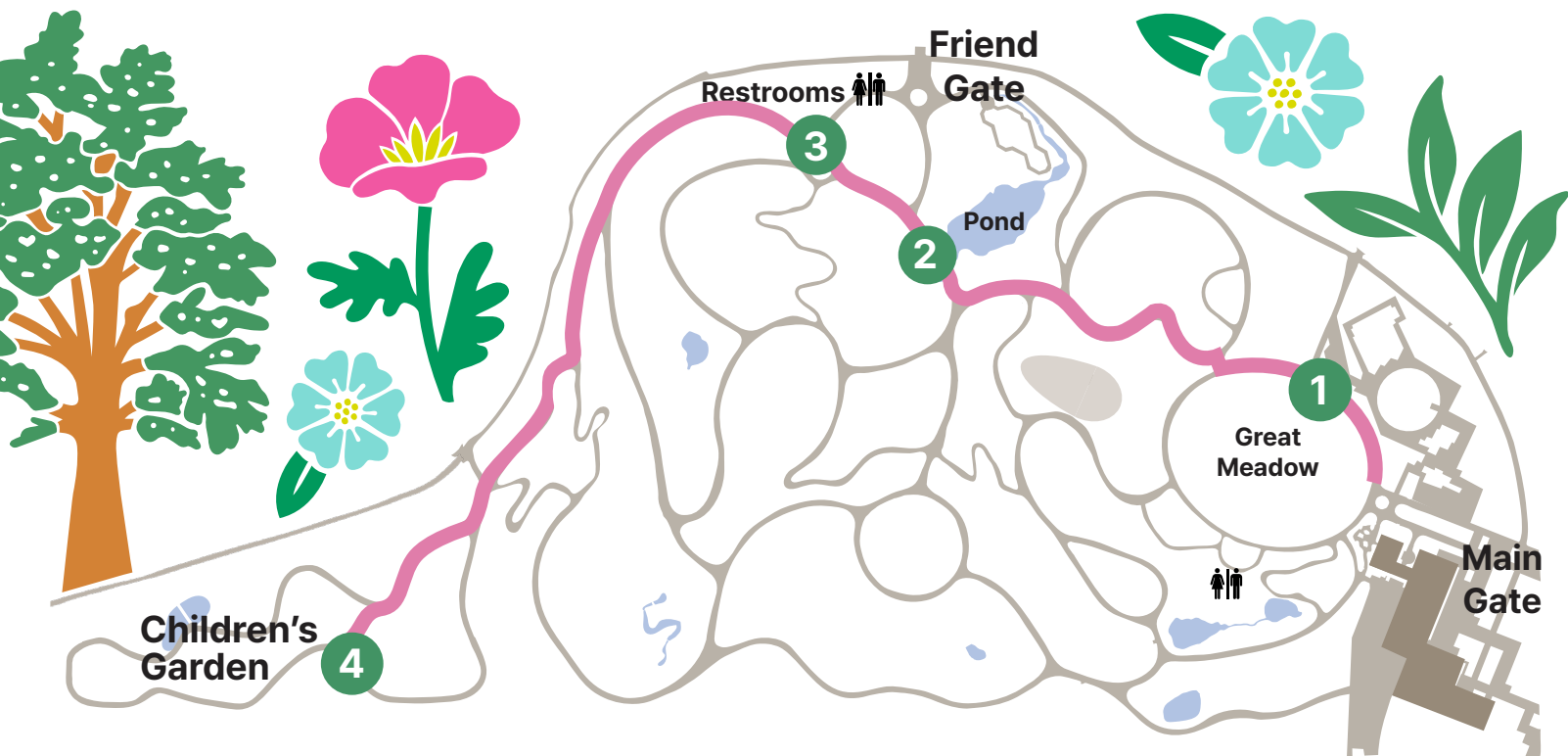
- 3 Look for the restroom sign – make a quick stop here and fill your water bottle. **If you entered through the Friend Gate, you will start near here.**

Listen and look for hummingbirds visiting the flowers around the garden!



- 4 Follow the trail along the fence line to the **Children's Garden**!

Can you find a leaf as small as your thumbnail?
As long as your leg? Shaped like your eye?
