


# GETTING TO THE GARDENS OF GOLDEN GATE PARK

-  **Public Street Parking**  
Available on Martin Luther King Jr. Dr, Nancy Pelosi Dr, Bowling Green Dr and around Blue Heron Lake.
-  **Parking Garage at the Music Concourse**  
From the north, enter the garage on Fulton St. at 10th Ave. From the south, drive into the park at 9th Ave. and enter the garage near the Bandshell. There is a fee to park.
-  **Free Accessible Parking at the Bandshell**  
The All-Accessible Lot has 20 accessible spaces, including four spaces for vans.
-  **Rideshare Drop-off for the Conservatory**  
Roads near the Conservatory of Flowers are car-free. The most accessible drop-off location is the "Goldman Tennis Center."

-  **Public Transportation (Muni)**  
San Francisco Muni serves the Gardens with the following lines: 5, 7, 43, 44, and N-Judah.
-  **Free Golden Gate Park Shuttle**

Weekends & holidays from 9:00am - 6:00pm
-  **Shuttle to Muni Transfer Points**  
Muni Routes and the Free Shuttle overlap in many places, offering easy transfers.
-  **Bike Racks**  
All Gardens have bike racks near their Entrances.

-  **Entrances to the Gardens**
-  **Stair-free pathways between Gardens**
- Walking and rolling times:**  
From A to B:  
10 minutes  
(0.5 miles / 0.8km)  
  
From B to C:  
2 minutes  
(480 ft. / 0.14km)  
  
From D to A:  
15 minutes  
(0.8 miles / 1.29 km)
