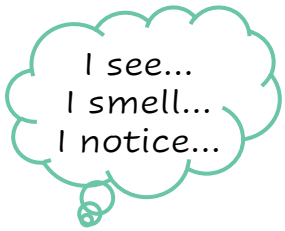


Field Trip Exploration Guide

- It's ok if each person has a different opinion or approach to answering this question.



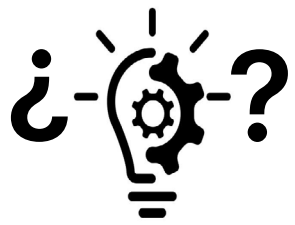
4. Chat & Reflect
